**1. CHAIRPERSON'S WELCOME**

The Mayor Rob Phillips extended a warm welcome to all present.

**2. APOLOGIES & PERSONAL MATTERS**

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Derek Wilson and Cllr Chris Thomas.

**3. PRESENTATION**

A presentation was delivered by Mr Simon Firth, Cycle-Mart, Cilcennin, in relation to the possibility of installing a Dirt-Track on the field.

This would involve approximately a fortnight's work, to include the use of a mini-digger. Mr Firth did not anticipate a large outlay, to bring the Dirt-Track to fruition. Input was also received from three youths of the area, namely Danny (James); Gethin (Bound) and Siôn (Knowles), who displayed enthusiasm for this project.

**Resolved**

***The Mayor agreed to visit the Dirt-Track, at Cilcennin to glean further ideas.***

**4. DISCLOSURES OF INTEREST**

There were no disclosures of interest.

**5. THE PREVIOUS MEETING OF THE 7<sup>th</sup> April** were agreed to be a correct record and were signed by the Chair.

**6. MATTERS ARISING**

**6.1 THE FENCE:** The work of installing the fence is almost completed by Mr Kevin Jones and Mr Emyr Jones, Teify Forge Ltd. An additional £500 to the original quote, will be necessary to meet the cost. ***(Cllr Derek Wilson/ Ivor Williams)***

**6.2 GRASS CUTTING:** To seek new tenders – 4 cuts for the whole of the field, to include the pitch and the grass-verge. One cut mid July; August; September; October ***(Clerk)***

**6.3 SEATS**

Two new metal seats have been purchased from Mr Alex Page, £325 each, ex VAT and are now a feature of the field. Also three redundant seats from the Parc-yr-orsedd, which were refurbished by Cllr Chris Thomas, have been relocated to the field. In addition, 5 picnic-benches have been positioned in one corner of the field.

**6.4 PATHS**

**Resolved**

*The Mayor to arrange a site-meeting with Mr Tony Eames to ask if it is possible for him to improve the condition of the footpath and to harden the surface. (Width of footpath – 1 metre)*

**6.5 THE LEASE**

**Resolved**

*The Mayor to write to the Ceredigion County Council to ask for an extension of 7 years in the term of the lease.*

**6.6 COLLECTING STONES from the field: *Lizzie James, possibly, to arrange this task.***

**6.7 THREE NEW SIGNS** will be displayed on the fence (*Cllr D.Wilson*) and the large gates will be bolted (*Cllr D. Wilson*). Dogs will be prohibited from using the field, in the interest of health and safety.

**6.8 EXPENDITURE**

It was reported, that after the end of the present 3 year lease, the field could be used for development purposes. It was therefore deemed, unwise, to spend vast amounts of money on the field, due to its uncertain future. Cllr Walters stated that if it could be shown, that there was a need for an amenity in this area, the Town Council would subsequently be in a stronger position to secure an extension.
