4. Y GIG YN NEUADD FICTORIA

Trefnir y Gig mewn partneriaeth â'r Urdd a *Chered*. Roedd y dyddiad gwreiddiol ar gyfer y Gig bellach wedi'i aildrefnu o ddydd Gwener 2ail o Fawrth 2018 i ddydd Sadwrn y 3ydd o Fawrth 2018. Cyfarfuwyd â disgyblion uwchradd Ysgol Bro Pedr yn ystod ymweliad y Gyngh. Ann Morgan a Steffan Rees, Cered â Ysgol Bro Pedr i drafod trefniadau mewn perthynas â'r Gig. Dywedwyd y byddai trefnu digwyddiad o'r fath yn hyrwyddo'r laith Gymraeg ymhlith Pobl Ifanc gan gwrdd â nifer o amcanion Cered. Bydd Ymddiriedolaeth Datblygu Transition Llambled yn cynnig y Neuadd Fictoria yn rhad ac am ddim ond bydd yn derbyn enillion y Bar. Gofynnwyd tybed a ellid cyflogi siaradwyr Cymraeg fel cynorthwywyr Bar. Bydd yn ofynnol i gwrdd â chostau Diogelwch yn ystod y noson £60 x 3. Bydd staff yr Urdd hefyd ar ddyletswydd.

Ystyriwyd Bandiau megis Fleur de Lys (cost amcangyfrifedig o £375) a Chandelas (£500); ceisir Band ychwanegol (gosodwyd cyllideb o £150). Bydd angen nawdd. Disgwylir perfformiadau gan fandiau lleol ar ddechrau'r gyngerdd, ee enillwyr Eisteddfod Bro Pedr. Cytunodd disgybl Uwch Ysgol Bro Pedr, sef Twm Ebsworth i ymwneud â'r rôl o DJ.

Tocynnau mynediad £10 / pen; £8 / pen os archebwyd ymlaen llaw; Gostyniadau ar gyfer Aelodau'r Urdd.

Bydd *Cered* yn gyfrifol am gyhoeddusrwydd yn ymwneud â'r Digwyddiad ac yn cynhyrchu Poster. Dywedwyd bod Prifysgol Cymru Y Drindod Dewi Sant, Llanbedr Pont Steffan wedi cyfrannu £300 i ddigwyddiad cynt a drefnwyd gan yr Urdd. **CYTUNWYD** i ofyn i'r PCYDDS tybed a fyddai hyn yn bosibl, unwaith eto.

Dywedodd Sian Elin, Swyddog yr Urdd fod ei horiau gwaith â Sefydliad yr Urdd wedi'u cyfyngu i 10 awr yr wythnos a chyda rhwymedigaethau eraill, ni allai gymryd rhan flaenllaw mewn trefniadau sy'n ymwneud â'r Gig. Serch hynny, roedd hi'n barod i gynnig rôl ategol.

Dywedodd y Cyng. Rob Phillips ei fod yn barod i hyrwyddo'r digwyddiad dan law Plattform Cymdeithasol y Cyngor Tref, sef Facebook a Thrydar.

1. CHAIRPERSON'S WELCOME

Deputy-Mayor of Lampeter, Town Councillor, Ann Morgan welcomed all to the meeting to include Manon Williams, a pupil from Ysgol Bro Pedr.

3. THE MARCH/PROCESSION

Date and Time

The Procession will be held on the afternoon of Friday 2nd March 2018 to start between (1.00pm-1.45pm). Pupils to return to the school by closing time.

Who will take part?

Schools within the Bro Pedr, Lampeter Catchment area, that is, Ysgol Bro Pedr; Carreg Hirfaen; Llanybydder; Bro'r Dderi; Dyffryn Cledlyn and Llanllwni (Years 5 & 6). Teachers will take responsibility for pupils in their care. It was agreed to find out the total number of Year 5 & 6 pupils of each school, within the catchment area. More pupils could possibly, be recruited to include older pupils from the senior school.

Organisations will be invited, for example Churches, Clubs & Choirs. WI; Hanes Llambod; Football/Rugby Clubs.

Mr Gwynne Davies had been contacted, in relation to the hire of a loudspeaker, which will lead the Procession, followed by the Cwmann Choir. It was asked whether Mr Davies would be able to provide the sound system at Parc-yr-Orsedd, immediately after the Procession. The matter had already been discussed with him and a fee of £100 quoted. It was agreed to discuss the matter, once again, with Mr Davies. Welsh songs will be played and words available, on sheets. It was agreed to make enquiries within the Printing Room University of Wales Trinity Saint David Lampeter in relation to the printing of the sheets. Each organisation represented, will fly a banner.

Traffic Control

AGREED: Cllr Rob Phillips will contact the Police/ County Council regarding Traffic Control. Stewarts will also be necessary and a vehicle should follow the Parade with a sign alerting people that a procession is underway. A Risk Assessment will be necessary and public liability insurance set in place.

Route to be taken

The Procession will start at Bro Pedr School, proceed past Hafan Deg Home; turn right for High Street; turn right for St Thomas' Street to the Cwmins- turn left for New Street and walk through New Street; Turn left to Bridge Street; proceed in the direction of Harford Square – turn right to College Street- turn left at the roundabout, for Parc-yr-Orsedd.

Pupils will then enter Victoria Hall. Sian Elin (Urdd) will lead a Jamboree at the hall at 2pm. Sally Saunders will host Line-Dancing activities and Face-Tattoos could be on offer (allergy-checks to be carried out in advance). The hall has been booked for the afternoon of Friday 2nd March 2017 (Cllr Ann Morgan).

Adults will enter Parc-yr-Orsedd, weather permitting; alternatively, they will be directed to a room, within Victoria Hall.

At Parc-yr-Orsedd

Mayor Cllr Hag Harris had agreed to open the Event at Parc-yr-Orsedd.

Prominent people within the community will be invited, for example:

Elin Jones AM; Ben Lake MP; Gary Slaymaker; Gwawr Edwards; Gillian Elisa and certain rugby players.

Cwmann Choir will sing at Parc-yr-Orsedd; it will be necessary to send a formal invitation to the Chair of Cwmann Choir. A stage will *not* be required. Ysgol Bro Pedr pupils will also perform at Parc-Yr-Orsedd.

4. THE GIG AT VICTORIA HALL

The Gig will be arranged in partnership with the *Urdd* and *Cered*. The original date set had now been rearranged from Friday 2nd March 2018 to Saturday 3rd March 2018. Cllr Ann Morgan and Steffan Rees, Cered had met with senior pupils of Ysgol Bro Pedr to discuss arrangements in relation to the Gig. It was stated that organising an event, such as this, would promote the Welsh Language amongst Young People and met many of Cered's objectives.

Transition Llambled Development Trust will offer the Victoria Hall free of charge but will receive the takings of the Bar. It was enquired whether Welsh speakers could be employed as Bar attendants. It will be necessary to meet Security costs during the evening £60 x 3. Urdd staff will also be on duty. Bands were considered viz Fleur de Lys (estimated cost £375) and Candelas (£500); it would also be attempted to find another Band (budget allocated £150). Sponsorship will be sought. Local bands will perform at the start of the concert, for example the winners of the Ysgol Bro Pedr Eisteddfod. Senior Ysgol Bro Pedr pupil, Twm Ebsworth, had agreed to the role of DJ. Entry tickets £10/head; £8/head if pre-booked; Concessions for Urdd Members.

Cered will publicise the Event and produce a Poster. It was stated that the UWTSD Lampeter had contributed £300 to a past Event organised by the Urdd. It was **AGREED** to ask the UWTSD whether this would be possible, once again.

Sian Elin, Urdd Officer stated that her hours of employment with the Urdd Organisation were confined to 10 hours per week and with other obligations, she could not take a prominent role in arrangements concerning the Gig. Nevertheless, she was more than happy to offer a supporting role. Cllr Rob Phillips said that he was prepared to promote the event via the Town Council's Social Platforms viz Facebook and Twitter.

5. WELSH TEAS and SHOP WINDOWS' DISPLAY

Certain cafes had been approached and were prepared to offer Welsh Teas eg Hedyn Mwstard; Mark Lane. Other cafes will be asked. It was **AGREED** to contact the Lampeter Chamber of Trade (Sarah: Stiwdio Print and Mel: Glynhebog) to find out further information. Shop Windows Displays' based on

the theme of St David, were also considered. Reference was drawn to the Lampeter Ale Festival. It was agreed to contact Tina Morris, Secretary of the Lampeter of Chamber of Trade to discuss further. The Mayor and Mayoress will judge the windows' display and prizes awarded to the first, second and third winners.

6. OTHER ACTIVITIES

6.1 Bunting/flags could be displayed within the town. It was **AGREED** to find out whether permission would be required from Ceredigion County Council to display the flags.

7. ADVERTISING THE EVENT

It was **AGREED** to place an article in the *Clonc* to advertise the event – February 2018.

8. SPONSORSHIP

Various organisations could be approached for example Cylch Cinio; Ras yr Iaith; Rotary; Round Table; UWTSD Lampeter; Schools; Community Councils, the Town Council and *Cered, Ras yr Iaith*. Dŵr Tŷ Nant, Llanllyr could be contacted (Tracy Edwards). Collection buckets were considered; a licence may be necessary.

9. AOB

Steffan Rees, Cered offered to design a poster outlining the events involved to mark St David's Day 2018 in Lampeter.

The meeting ended at 8.25pm.
