- 1. Chair Welcome:** The Mayor, Cllr. Ann Morgan welcomed all present to the meeting.
- 2. Present:** The Mayor Cllr. Ann Morgan, Sarah Ward (Chamber of Trade, Totally Local), Hazel Lubran, (CAVO), Kyle Erickson (UWTSD), Meryl Thomas (Town Clerk).
- 3. Apologies:** The Deputy Mayor Cllr. Rob Phillips, Cllr. Helen Thomas, Cllr. Rhys Bebb Jones, Nicola Doyle (Artisans), Sian Davies (Chairman Chamber of Trade)
- 4. Minutes:** The minutes of the meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> October were agreed and signed by The Mayor Cllr. Ann Morgan
- 5. Love Lampeter:** It was agreed to arrange to get all the cards to the student at CAVO so he can collate all the suggestions.
- 6. Forum:** It was decided to discuss this at a later date.
- 7. Plans:** Sarah Ward had a poem written about Lampeter in English for the vinyl on the outside of the old Spar shop, the clerk will ask Delor James if she could write something in Welsh. Sarah has also contacted the Family Centre to request pictures from children for the vinyl. Hazel Lubran will ask A F Blakemore about going in to the old Spar shop to tidy it up. The clerk will ask Kevin in the print unit in the University about a banner with Love Lampeter on it to put on the top on the shop. Kyle Erickson will ask the University for a donation towards the banner. Gary Thorogood from Transition Llambled had enquired about the Victoria Hall having a notice board on the Spar window. Sarah Ward suggested setting up a Love Lampeter Instagram page.

The Mayor Cllr. Ann Morgan confirmed that the mural which was to be painted by Rhiannon Roberts and the children from local schools which was to be placed on the W.D. Lewis wall had been postponed by the Gwyl Dewi committee as they

thought it was a lot of money to spend on something that would not last long. Jewson had donated the plywood, £500.00 from the Town Council £100.00 from LAS and £100.00 from UWTSD. Kyle Erickson suggested to still paint the mural and maybe get it placed somewhere else where it would not be affected by the weather. Sarah Ward said that we could take a photo of the mural and digitalize it so it could be used to make Christmas cards etc. Hazel Lubran also suggested once it was digitalized it could be printed on vinyl to put on empty shop windows. The Place Plans committee suggested taking over the painting of the mural. The Mayor Cllr. Ann Morgan is going to go back to the committee to see if they would change their mind about the mural.

Market Street needs developing, maybe reinstate a market there and maybe have small cabins or gazebos. Covered walkway on Market Street so people could sit and have food.

More benches needed around town for people to sit when walking around town and connect the town. Maybe businesses in town could sponsor benches.
