Sub-committee meeting to agree policy on parity of donations

PLEASE NOTE: In order to qualify, ALL ORGANISATIONS must work within the local community. That is, be of benefit to Lampeter DOMESTIC rate payers (who pay Lampeter Town Council's precept through the Domestic Rates system).

It was agreed that donations fall into 3 broad categories:

1. Events
2. Voluntary support services (including cultural organisations such as the Urdd)
3. One-off Donations These are further sub-divided into:

EVENTS

- a) Major annual events who receive an annual donation of £500.00 +
Lampeter Eisteddfod £1,000.00
Lampeter Food Festival £1,000.00
Lampeter Agricultural Show £500.00
Lampeter Carnival £500.00
Lampeter Fireworks £500.00 (to bring them in-line with other events) Gŵyl
Golwg £500.00
- b) Events which receive between £250.00 and £499.00
- c) Events which receive between £101.00 and £249.00
- d) Events which receive up to £100.00

VOLUNTARY SUPPORT SERVICES

- a) £500.00 + e.g. Citizens Advice Bureau £500.00
- b) £250.00 and £499.00
- c) £101.00 and £249.00
- d) Up to £100.00

ONE-OFF DONATIONS

- a) £500.00 + e.g. Swimming Pool £15,000.00, Victoria Hall £20,000.00 and Lampeter Family Centre £5,000.00

b) £250.00 and £499.00

c) £101.00 and £249.00

d) Up to £100.00

Young People/Individuals requesting financial support must live within the Lampeter Ward.
